

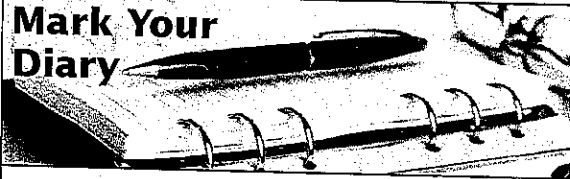

KATHERINE HARTMAN TO RECEIVE OUTSTANDING WOMAN IN PROFESSION AWARD



Reception slated for January 19

The Women in the Profession Committee will host its 3rd annual Winter Reception on **Tuesday, January 19, 6 p.m.** at Scaturro's in Marlton, at which they will present the first Outstanding Woman in the Profession Award to Katherine D. Hartman.

During her Association presidency in 2013, Hartman formed the Women in the Profession Committee, a committee dedicated to furthering the causes of women in the profession and expanding upon the valuable contributions women have made to the legal profession and to the Burlington County Bar Association. The Committee recently created the Outstanding Woman in the Profession Award to recognize a member who not only has made significant contributions to the Burlington County Bar but to the legal profession and surrounding community, and selected Ms. Hartman as its first recipient.

A longtime member of the Burlington County Bar Association, Hartman served on the Board of Trustees for 8 years, culminating in her presidency for the 2013-14 Bar year. Additionally, Hartman served as president of the Burlington County Bar Foundation, the charitable arm of the Association, for Bar year 2009-2010, and continues to serve on the Foundation's Board of Trustees. 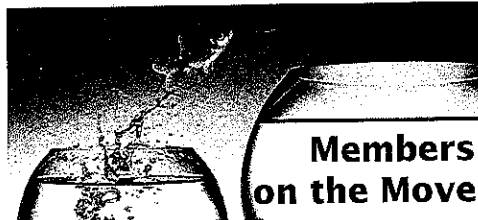
NOMINATIONS SOUGHT FOR BCBA BOARD OF TRUSTEES
